We extend our gratitude to the team of doctors and healthcare professionals who are involved in the design process, giving valuable inputs on architectural layouts and workflow.


All of us here are happy to be one step closer to establishing a hospital that is *like no other*. We will keep you updated as the construction continues to come together.



# IS IT SAFE TO POSTPONE HEART SURGERY DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

because symptoms of Covid-19 can be more severe in patients with heart disease The Covid-19 pandemic sweeping the world has fundamentally disrupted the order in our lives. The outbreak has also affected medical services for other illnesses and health conditions, including heart surgery and society's general perceptions about health services. Does heart surgery still need to commence during the Covid-19 pandemic? Is it safe to postpone scheduled cardiac surgery? What are the dangers of delaying heart surgery in certain cases? This article will answer these questions that have arisen in the community.

#### When Can Heart Surgery be Delayed?

We recommend that you discuss the severity of your heart disease with your cardiologist or surgeon to determine if the surgical procedure can be postponed until the Covid-19 crisis is over. The symptoms of a heart attack may initially appear mild and present themselves only during strenuous activity. If these symptoms below appear when resting or persist after resting, then this is a sign that your heart condition has worsened and requires immediate medical attention. If ignored, you may be at risk of sudden cardiac arrest that can be fatal.


# Symptoms that indicate you might be having a heart attack include:

- Left-sided chest pain without a pinpoint location, feels like there is intense pressure on the chest
- Chest pain that radiates to the neck, back and arms
- Difficulty breathing
- · Dizziness, feeling faint
- · Cold sweat
- · Can be accompanied by nausea and vomiting

It is important to weigh the risk of delaying the surgical procedure against the risk of being exposed to Covid-19 when leaving the home or at the hospital, because symptoms of Covid-19 can be more severe in patients with heart disease, as stated by the Indonesian Association of Cardiovascular Specialists (PERKI). Also, as recovery from heart surgery requires you to have a robust immune system that is free from infection, if you are a heart disease patient who has tested positive for Covid-19, it's recommended that you postpone heart surgery until you recover from Covid-19.

# What are Mandaya Hospitals Doing to Keep Patients Safe?

Since the start of the Covid-19 outbreak in Indonesia, hospitals have adjusted to implement measures to fight the pandemic and protect patients and medical personnel, from designating special isolation rooms, strict screening of patients before they undergo surgical procedures, to the required use of personal protective equipment (PPE). All visitors and medical personnel are required to follow strict protocols such as wearing masks, social distancing, and frequent hand washing.

The Mandaya Teleconsultation Specialist service also allows patients to consult with doctors from home using a mobile phone that has a video call or conferencing application. Only if a physical examination is needed will the patient will be asked to visit the hospital. Efforts to break the chain of Covid-19 transmission are indeed very important, but patients with severe heart disease who require prompt treatment or cardiac surgery should contact the hospital to determine the most appropriate action to save lives.


# Cardio-Vascular Arrhythmia Center
